ARUNDEL'S BY THE PIER

White

Le Petit Pont - Languedoc - France Organic btl 25.90 | gl 6.30
Chardonnay, Vermentino
Aromatic and fruity but also elegant. A brilliant all rounder and great bang for your buck.

Ana - Marlborough - New Zealand btl 38.00 | gl 9.20
Sauvignon Blanc
Ripe tropical fruits kept wonderfully fresh by good acidity. A perennial favourite from NZ's most famous wine region.

Guilhem Blanc, Moulin de Gassac - Languedoc, France btl 27.50
Sauvignon Blanc, Grenache White, Terret Blanc
Splendidly lively from our neighbours in Kilcrohane. Super fresh nose, lovely light yellow fruits on the palate. Practically jumps out of the glass!

Dveri Pax - Kakovostno - Slovenia btl 37.50
Furmint, Pinot Gris
Named for the monks who began making wine here a thousand years ago. Refined and elegant nose, citrus and white flowers on the palate. Hallelujah.

Cú Cú - Falerio - Italy - Organic btl 32.50 | gl 7.9
Trebbiano, Passerina, Pecorino
Lucious white fruits balanced by crisp acidity. Named for the sound of the trains which pass by this organic vineyard. Choo choo, baby!

Elias Mora Verdejo - Rueda - Spain Organic btl 33.00 | gl 8.30
Intense greenish-golden colour with notes of candied citrus peel and anise-like background over hints of ripe pineapple. The palate is fresh and rich simultaneously, with a long aftertaste of fennel and fruit flavours.

Le Pont de Gassac, Moulin de Gassac - Languedoc - France btl 45.00
Chardonnay, Viognier, Sauvignon Blanc
Intense aromas of oranges and white flowers on the nose. Fruity on the palate with a touch of honey. Long and strong, fresh and full finish. Such a great wine from the premier cru of the Languedoc.

Natural Wines

330slm, Costadila - Colli Trevigiani - Italy Organic | Natural 50.00
Glera
A sparkling wine not dissimilar to Prosecco. This is how Italy's most famous export used to taste. Bracing acidity and beautiful citrus on the palate make this an ideal aperitivo for a warm summer evening. A real zesty little number!

La Sapata - Podgoria Sarica Niculitel DOC - Romania Organic | Natural 45.00
Aligoté
Aligoté plays second fiddle to chardonnay in white Burgundy, but this wine, made organically, using traditional methods is every bit as good as a premier cru!

Blanc Sense Papers, Bodegas Clandestina - Penedes, Spain Organic | Natural 50.00
Xarel-lo
A deep connection to the land and lost traditions of wine making in Catalonia is reflected both in how this wine is made and the way it tastes. The maker of this wine, Ferran Lacruz Bosch, favours older, organic vineyards and no additives or manipulation in the winery in order to achieve the purest possible expression of the grape and the terroir.

O Troncado, La Perdida - Galicia - Spain Organic | Natural 55.00
Garnacha Tintorera, Mencia
La Perdida means "the lost one" in Spanish and refers to the neglected and forgotten vines of this part of Galicia which are used to make this wine. Granite soil and indigenous grapes give this serious energy and fruit. A great place to start for those curious about the world of natural wine!

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Red

Le Petit Pont - Languedoc - France Organic btl 25.90 | gl 6.30
Merlot, Granache, Cinsault
Juicy fruit and soft tannins make this a beautiful all rounder.

Le Rondon - Rioja - Spain btl 34.00
Tempranillo
This is a classic from Spain's most loved wine region. Dark fruit on the nose with some spiciness from the oak and silky mouthfeel. An old reliable!

Cíu Cíu - Baccus - Italy Organic btl 32.50 | gl 7.9
Sangiovese, Montepulciano
A wine we will never take off the menu! Delicious ripe fruit on the palate - raspberry and cherry - with hints of liquorice, ending off with a lovely savoury finish. Brilliant in every month of the year.

Le Bio Balthazar - Minervois - France btl 30.00 | gl 7.7
Syrah, Grenache
Rich and complex nose with hints of the wild thyme which grows in this part of France. Full bodied with blackcurrant and black cherry on the palate. A bit moody, a bit French, very delicious.

Guilhem Rouge, Moulin de Gassac - Languedoc - France btl 27.00
Granache, Syrah, Craignan
Red berries and spice on the nose, delicate and sophisticated palate, long finish. Those who have been lucky to travel to the vineyard for the harvest will recognise this wine from the extraordinary lunches hosted by the Guibert family!

Le Pont de Gassac, Moulin de Gassac - Languedoc - France btl 45.00
Cabernet Sauvignon, Syrah, Merlot, Grenache
The king of grapes (Cab. Sauv.) dominates here. This wine represents everything good about the Guibert family's wines. The nose is expressive and complex, the palate is powerful but elegant and fresh and the finish is long and satisfying.

Rose

Domaine de Millet - Midi, Cotes de Gascogne - France btl 28.50 | gl 7.20
Egiodola, Syrah and Merlot.
Lovely crushed berry scents and flavours and a bright, fruity palate perfect for all day, everyday!

Sparkling

San Simone Frizzante - Prosecco DOC btl 33.00 | gl 7.00
This Prosecco from Italy is full of fruit and zest. Light, dry and refreshing with notes of crisp apple and citrus. Fun, amazingly easy, perfect for summer drinking one its own, or in an Aperol Spritz!

Mas de Daumas Gassac Rosé Frizzante - Languedoc - France btl 65.00
70% Cabernet Sauvignon, 30% Mourvèdre, Pinot noir, Sauvignon, Petit Manseng and Muscat.
This is an absolutely brilliant wine, but no need to take our word for it. This is from world renowned wine writer, Jancis Robinson: "so unpretentiously lovely and delight-delivering that it actually made me happy the moment I tasted it... it's the kind of wine that will go with absolutely anything you want it to".
